**SUMMER SERMON SERIES: PHILIPPIANS** - This summer, through August 9, we invite you to journey with us through Paul's letter to the Philippians. Philippians is a letter written to ordinary people living through an uncertain season. They were learning to follow Christ in a divided world, wondering what faithfulness looked like and how to hold onto hope when life didn't unfold as they expected. In many ways, their story isn't all that different from ours. Throughout the summer, we'll discover that the Christian life is lived between what God has already begun and what God has not yet finished. We are often impatient for change, in ourselves, in our relationships, in our communities, and in our world. Yet Paul gently reminds us that growth rarely happens overnight. Instead, we are invited to trust that the one who began a good work in us and the world will see it to completion. Together we'll explore themes of joy, perseverance, suffering, unity, humility, and grace. Whether you've been part of Trinity for decades or you're joining us for the first time, we hope you'll come and be encouraged. There is good reason for hope. God has not finished with us yet.
